## Important Fundraising notes

1. We raised a total of \$1,130 for the donation quilt. Thank you to everyone that contributed time on the quilt and sold tickets. This is below our budget projection of \$1500, and with a \$25.00/member requirement, means that only about 45 of our roughly 55 members participated. (Some actually contributed more and we had a small amount of outside sales so the total number of participants may be less.)

2. The Senior Center will again have a **craft sale at the center on Nov 8 (Friday 9-6) and Nov 9 (Saturday 9-noon)**. We will need a few things:

1. Please sign up for a time slot if you are able. We will have 2- hour time slots each day. Sign-up sheet available at each meeting leading up to the event or you can contact Nancy Harris prior to October 21st via e-mail or phone.

2. Please bring small **pre-priced** items for sale that you have made (they do not have to be quilting related). You can bring them to BOM (first Monday of the month), Therapy Day, or any meeting. Christmas themed items would sell especially well at this time of year. Don't forget that October's therapy day will have 3 stations, one with card making, one with Christmas ornaments, and one with wool mug rugs. All could make nice sale items. You will be able to bring items during setup time as well. More information will be forthcoming.

3. **No** food products are allowed for sale. No **non**-hand-made items are permitted, but if you have a hobby not quilting related, you are welcome to contribute those items as well. We are well below budget for fundraising, so let's finish up with a strong showing at the center.
